

HOW TO REPLACE SAMSUNG S3 BATTERY

Discharge battery first before repair



1 UNCLIP CASE

Use a plastic spudger to remove the Samsung S3 outer case. Pry the case loose on the right side first.



2 REPEAT STEP 1 ON ALL SIDES

Continue to pry the case off on all four sides using the plastic spudger or your fingers.



3 REMOVE THE CASE

Take off the back plastic casing. All the clips should be detached and it should come right off easily.



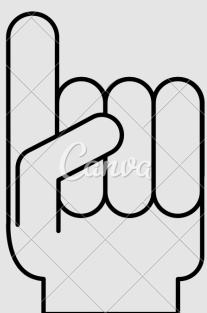
4 PRY THE BATTERY OUT

Wedge a plastic tool into the top left of the battery and gently pry it up. Alternatively you can use your fingernails or a small plastic pick. There is no adhesive so it should come out easily.



5 REMOVE THE S3 BATTERY

Finally remove the Samsung S3 battery and insert a fresh battery from gadgetsandbatteries.com



6 DISPOSE OF OLD BATTS

Make sure to follow local laws when disposing of lithium batteries.
